

Dear NARST conference presenters,

In accordance with NARST Policies and Procedures, authors presenting either a paper or a poster are required to have a manuscript for distribution, either via the NARST Conference CD (which is made available to all conference attendees) or distributed at the paper or poster presentation session. The deadline for receipt of your manuscript for the NARST Conference CD is February 24, 2012.

Your manuscript must be sent electronically as a PDF file to info@narst.org. All manuscripts received by the deadline will be included in the NARST Conference CD and will be distributed to all conference attendees along with the conference program. Please note that your submission to the NARST Conference CD is voluntary.

Please use the following formats for submitting either a paper or poster file:

last name_2012NARST_poster.pdf

The CD is a convenience available to conference presenters, which enables you to not have to bring sufficient hard copies of your manuscript for distribution at the conference. In accordance with the NARST contract with Wiley-Blackwell, the CD is not available through any other means other than inclusion with the conference program for distribution to conference attendees. Please note that the NARST Conference CD is not posted on the NARST website; and, the NARST Conference CD is not a proceedings of the conference.

In past years we have sent you a template detailing the process for submitting your manuscript. This year we have decided not to do this. Instead, please visit <http://apastyle.apa.org/>, which provides you with the 6th Edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association's paper writing guidelines. Please follow APA's paper writing guidelines for your NARST 2012 conference manuscript.

Remember also that all first authors must register for the conference by March 3, 2012. Advance registration for the 2012 NARST Annual International Conference is available online at: <http://narst.org/annualconference/2012conference.cfm>. Your presentation will be removed from the program if the first author does not register by this important deadline. In the event you are co-presenting with a first author who is not a NARST member, then please be inform your co-presenter of these upcoming deadlines.
