### Registration Reminder:

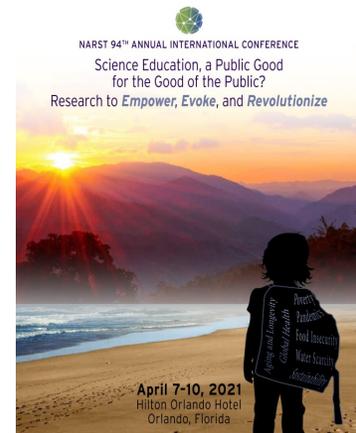
- All poster presenters **must** be registered for the conference to participate. Please [click here](#) to register.

### Conference Format Reminders:

- The Preliminary Schedule of Presentations can be found [here](#) and lists the day and time of your poster. **Unlike an in-person conference, the group to which your poster was assigned will open at 8:00 a.m. and will be available for viewing by attendees for 23 hours. During the 23-hour window, attendees have the option to communicate with you by way of chat.**

### Poster Presentation Format:

- [Click here for the eposter template](#). **Please** use the template. Because many posters will be displayed for attendees to peruse and read, a standardized template will enable attendees to focus more quickly on the content in lieu of navigating an array of formats—a tax on cognitive processing. that you submit your presentation in this PPT template.
- The eposter template is standardized in terms of its size. Please do not change the overall size or **increase** the number of boxes/sections. Please feel free to change the color scheme, the header/title for boxes/sections, decrease the



number of boxes/sections, and add any information you deem pertinent to your work. The information (text, pictures, and graphs) are included for illustration purposes only.

- You must also submit a thumbnail image (350x600) to be the display image of your poster in the gallery view. To produce this image, simply screenshot your poster and save as a jpeg in the specified dimensions above.

### Poster Presentation Recording Information:

- In addition to your poster, you have the option to submit a recorded video presenting your poster. The recording can be no more than **10-minutes** in length.
- There are two methods of recording your presentation we recommend; through PPT or Zoom. Both Zoom and PPT allow you to toggle your video on or off should you want to just overlay audio to your presentation without video. Instruction on both can be found in this [recording guide](#), slides 5-10.
- Regardless of the recording option you chose, the downloaded file must be in an **MP4** format.

### Submitting Your Material:

- A link to submit your presentation will be sent from the conference platform (OpenWater) no later than **March 5<sup>th</sup>**. This link will prompt you to upload your poster, thumbnail, and recording (if applicable) directly to your session in the platform.
- All material is due **Wednesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>**
